

Upon submission of this application, Washington Federal Bank (the "Bank") will process the request to determine if the account will be opened.

This process applies to the following account funding methods: credit or debit card, transfer from an account at another financial institution, or transfer from your existing Washington Federal Bank account. If we are unable to open the account based on the information provided in the application, a charge will not be assessed on your selected funding method. You will receive an email notification to the address you have provided in one to three business days if the account is not opened.

If the Bank approves and processes your application, then the selected funding method discussed above will be charged for the amount of the initial deposit you provided. Once the Bank notifies you that your application has been approved, you will need to sign the signature card to complete the account opening. If you do not sign the signature card within ten days of receiving this notice from the Bank, then the account is not opened and the amount of the initial deposit will be refunded to you. You will receive an email notification to the address you have provided if the account is not opened and the initial deposit is refunded.

Once your signed signature card is received by the Bank and the account is opened, the amount of the initial deposit will be available on the day that it is received into your new account with the Bank, which may take up to three business days. We reserve the right to close your account at any time. If your new account is opened and funded with the initial deposit and we close your account, we will advise you in writing that we have done so and the final balance on the account (less any amounts owed to us) will either be mailed to you by check or be credited back onto the card used for the initial deposit.

## **CONSENT**
