

WaFd Bank offers a secure online process to borrowers to review and eSign loan disclosures and documentation. There are several ways you can create your Borrower Portal:

Via a Click here to visit the website link included in an email from WaFd Bank – Note: when using an email link, you may be prompted to enter an authorization code. The authorization code will be the last four digits of your social security number.


Your loan application is available to view on our secure, password-protected website. Click here to visit the website and access the loan and eSign documents.

When applying for a loan at wafdbank.com – Note: this option is only available to borrowers working with a
WaFd Loan Officer, if you are working with an independent Mortgage Broker who offers WaFd Bank loan
products, use the email link process to create your portal account.

Borrowers can share an email address, but *each borrower must complete the steps below* to create their individual Borrower Portal accounts for disclosure signing purposes.


Account Creation:

1. When prompted, click Create Account at the bottom of the log in page:






2. Complete all fields. If you share an email address with a co-borrower, be sure to create a unique *Username* to ensure you can each view your separate loan packages.


3. Create a password following the *Password Requirements* and complete the *I'm not a robot* CAPTCHA checkbox, then click *Create Account*:

4. You will be returned to the *Log In* page. Enter your newly created credentials and click *Log In*.
